The public on-site hearing for the Wharves and Weirs application for the Dana & Melissa Whitley wharf project was held as advertised on Friday December 12th at 9 A.M.

Joseph LeBlanc represented the owners and explained the project . The town of Boothbay was represented by Mike Tomacelli (planning board), and I.
