The public on-site hearing for the Wharves and Weirs application for the James and Andrea Clark ramp & float project was held as advertised on Monday January 26th at 9:30 A.M.

Joseph LeBlanc represented the owners and explained the project . The town of Boothbay was represented by myself. Abutter Jason Sheckley attended as well.

There does not seem to be any effect of diminished or restricted ingress or egress by riparian owners. There is no evidence that this project will cause injury to others that use the area in Hodgdon Island gut.
